

Born in Wedel in 1870, the sculptor, draftsman and writer **Ernst Barlach** is today considered one of the most famous Expressionist artists. His artistic career began in the late 1880s when he began an apprenticeship as a commercial drawing teacher and soon after transferred to the Royal Academy of Fine Arts in Dresden, where his final project was a sculpture, called Krautpflückerin. Barlach returned again to Hamburg after a period of study in Paris and work commissions in Berlin and worked there as a sculptor, draftsman and also began to create vases and ceramic objects for the Mutz manufactory in Altona. In the late summer of 1906, Barlach traveled to Kharkov, Belgorod and the Donbas, for a family visit with his brother Nikolaus, where he encountered Russian peasants and beggars, who soon became the most important motif in his sculptural art. The simple and poor people of the southern Russian steppe had a lasting influence on him and marked his breakthrough as a sculptor: the round sculpture 'Russian Beggar Woman with Bowl', like the smaller first version of 'Russian Beggar Woman II', was exhibited at the Berlin Secession in 1907. It was followed by numerous figures depicting the marginalized groups of society and dealing - similar to his literary works - with the fundamental questions about man in the modern world. The art dealer Paul Cassirer took Barlach under contract for a fixed annual salary and took over all his works. Shortly thereafter, the artist became a member of the Berlin Secession, whose president Max Liebermann had poached Cassirer as a board member a few years earlier. Liebermann saw in Barlach an artist 'sui generis'. Barlach's rendering of social maladjustment caused him to become denounced as a degenerate artist under National Socialism, and his works were dismantled and destroyed. Some of the artist's objects have nevertheless been preserved and show to this day (as here as a stoneware figure of the 'Russian Beggar Woman with Bowl' from 1906 and the larger posthumous bronze casting 'Russian Beggar Woman II' from 1932) how truthfully and unadorned Barlach understood how to portray people.


